- 6. **Streamline Content Management**: Integrate a user-friendly content management system (CMS) to facilitate easy updates and maintenance by Carmichael team.
- 7. **Enhance Security**: Upgrade security measures to protect against cyber threats and ensure the safety of user data.
- 8. **Migration** of goodgovernanceawards.ie to carmichaelireland.ie
